How to Save Google Earth Data

How to Save Google Earth Data



You can import data from Google Earth into Korero Takutai. All you need to do is to save it in the right file format.



1. Use Google Earth to prepare the data you wish to use in Korero Takutai. The data in the image comprises a polygon and some points.



2. The data should be stored in either the 'My Places' or 'Temporary Places' folders in the window to the right-hand side of the map.



3. Right click on the root folder that your data is stored in. Select 'save place as' from the menu.



4. Select which folder on your computer you would like to save the data to, and the name you would like to give the



5. Select 'Kml' from the 'save as type' drop-down menu. This is very important as Kmz files are not compatible with Korero Takutai. Then click 'save'.
