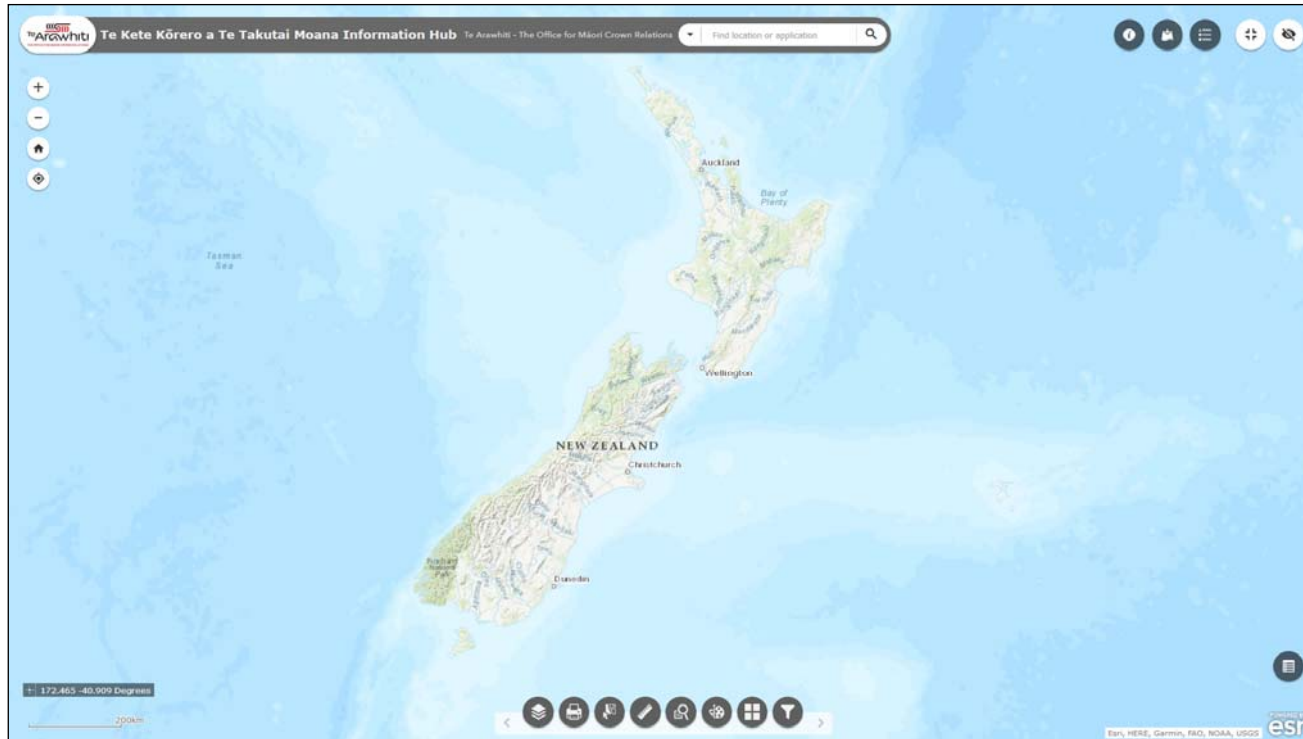


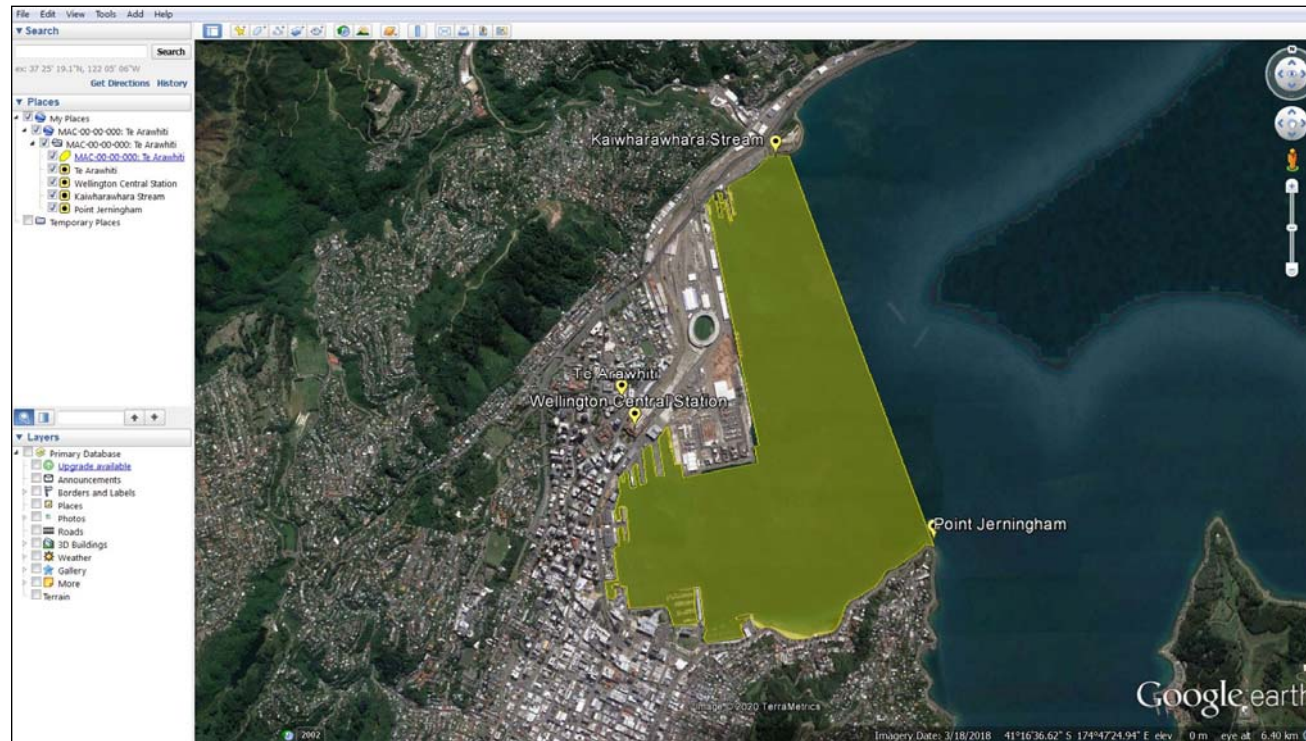

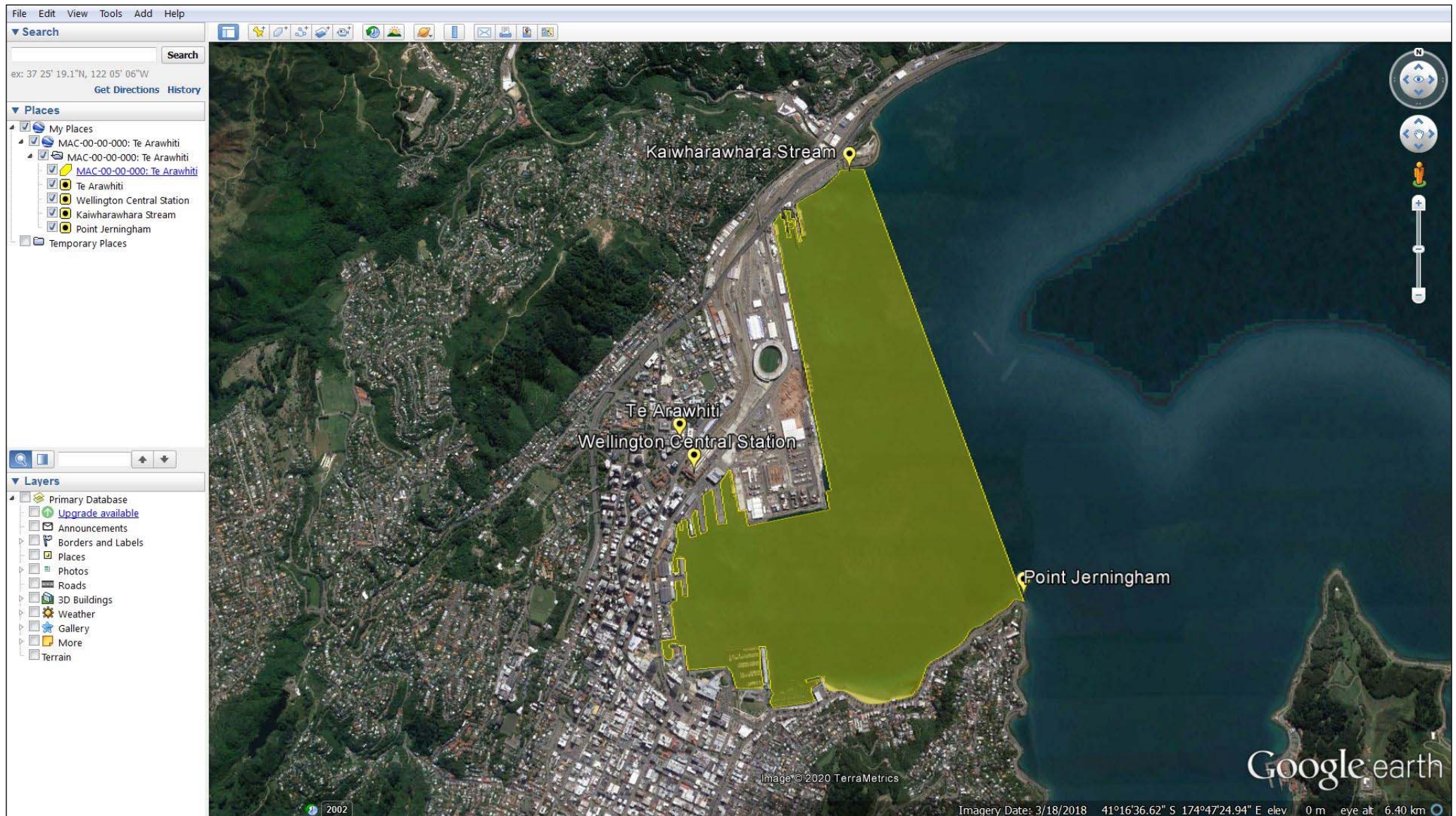
How to Save Google Earth Data



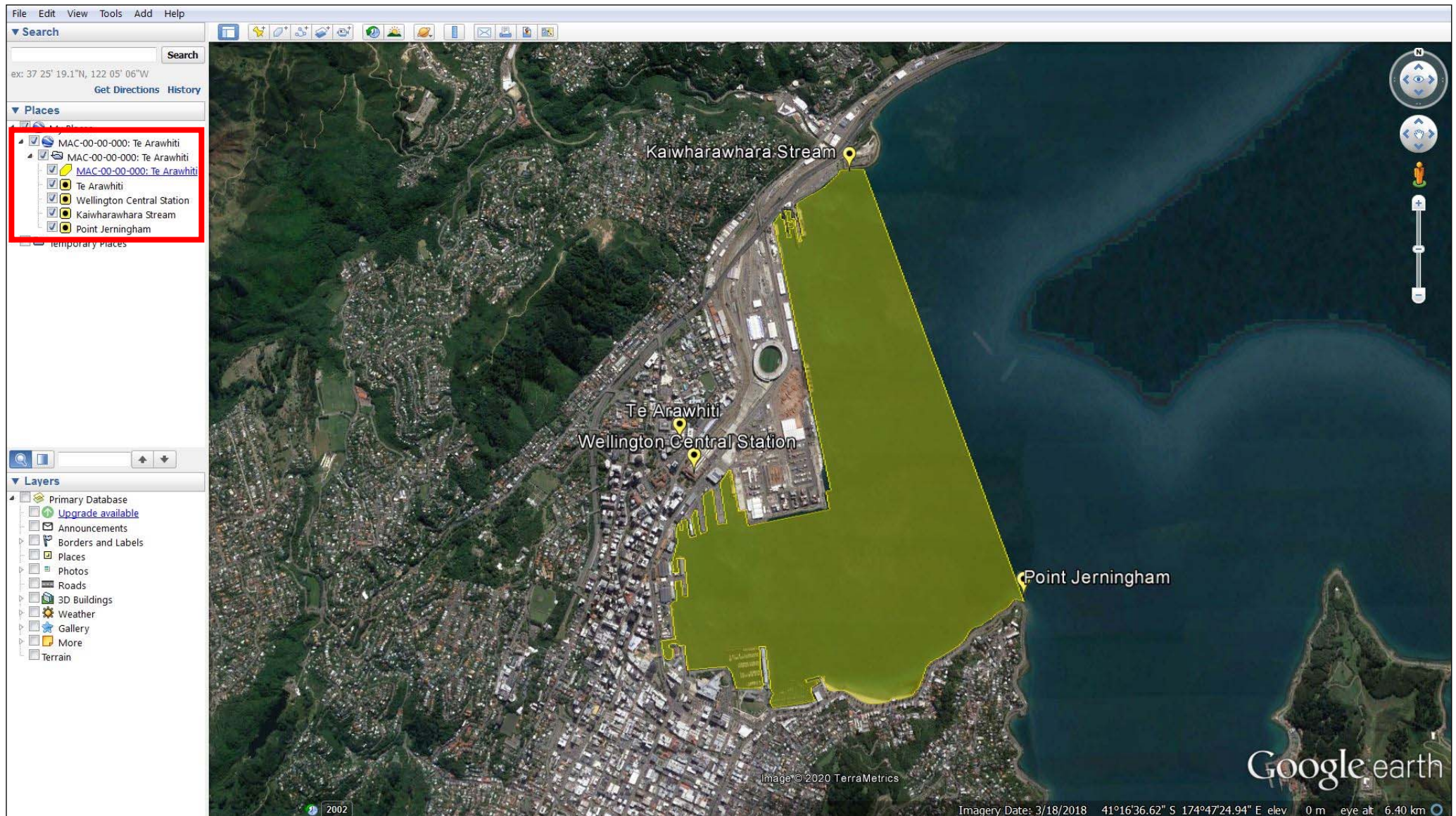
How to Save Google Earth Data



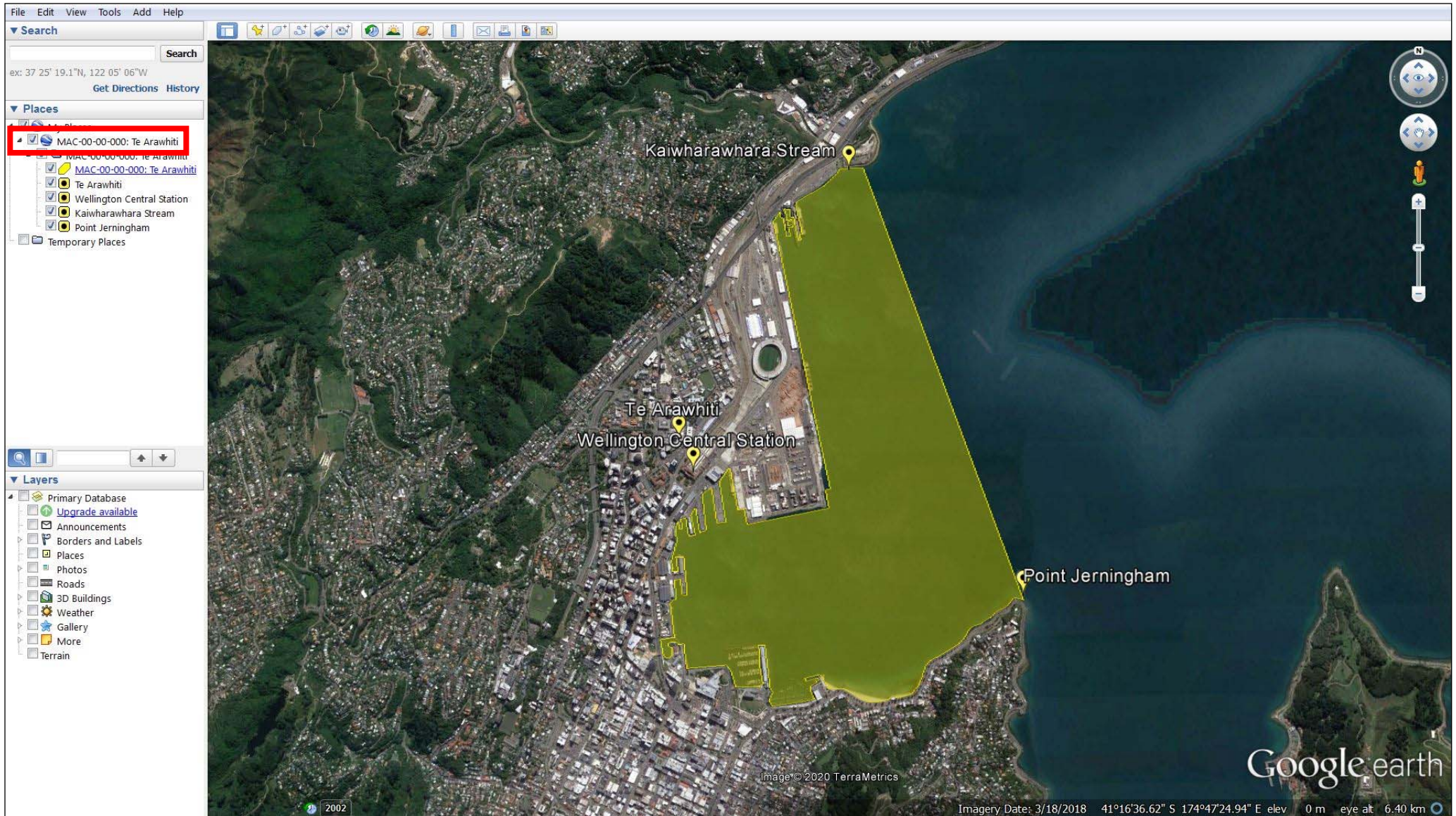
You can import data from Google Earth into Kōrero Takutai. All you need to do is to save it in the right file format.



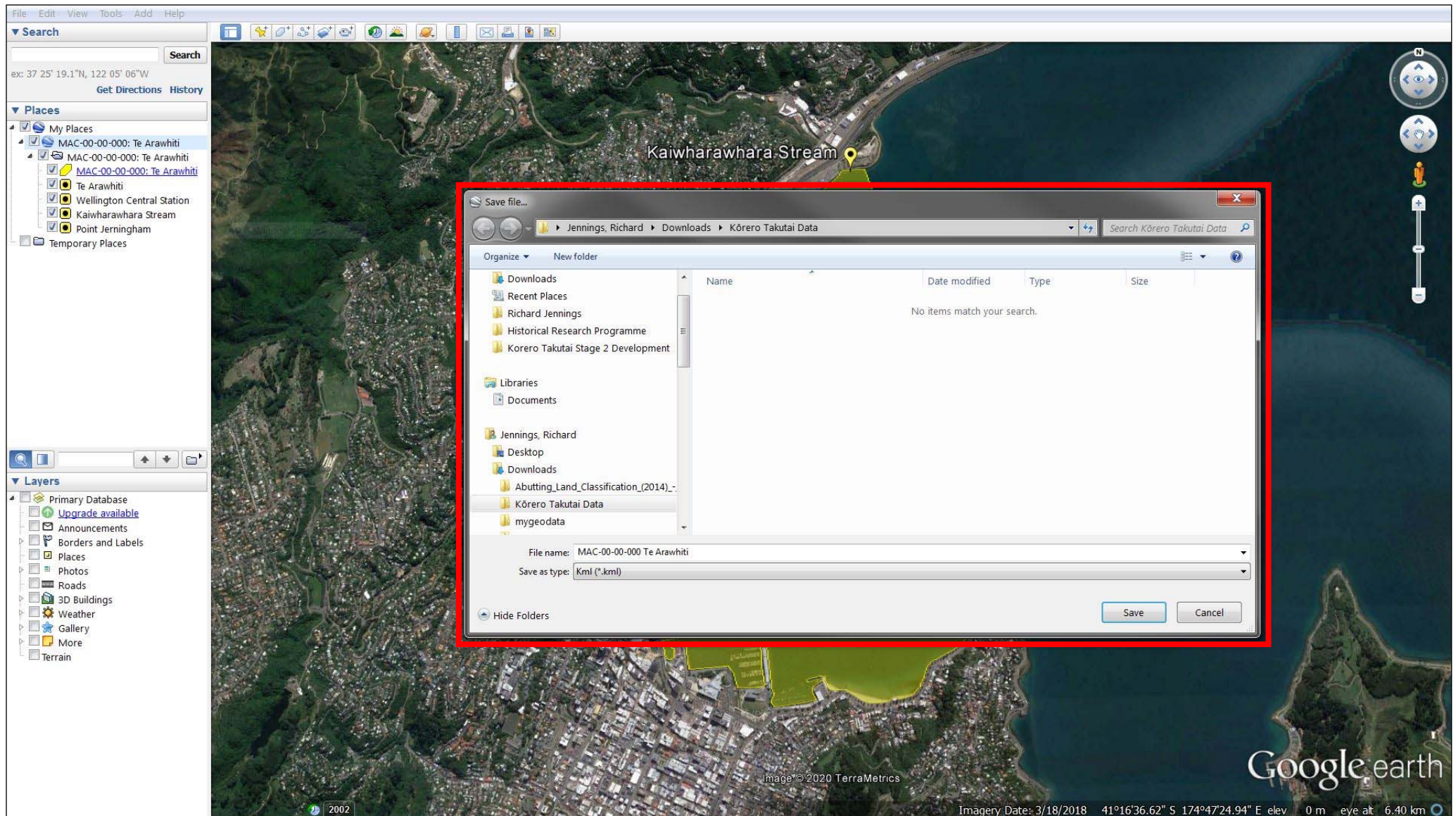
1. Use Google Earth to prepare the data you wish to use in Kōrero Takutai. The data in the image comprises a polygon and some points.



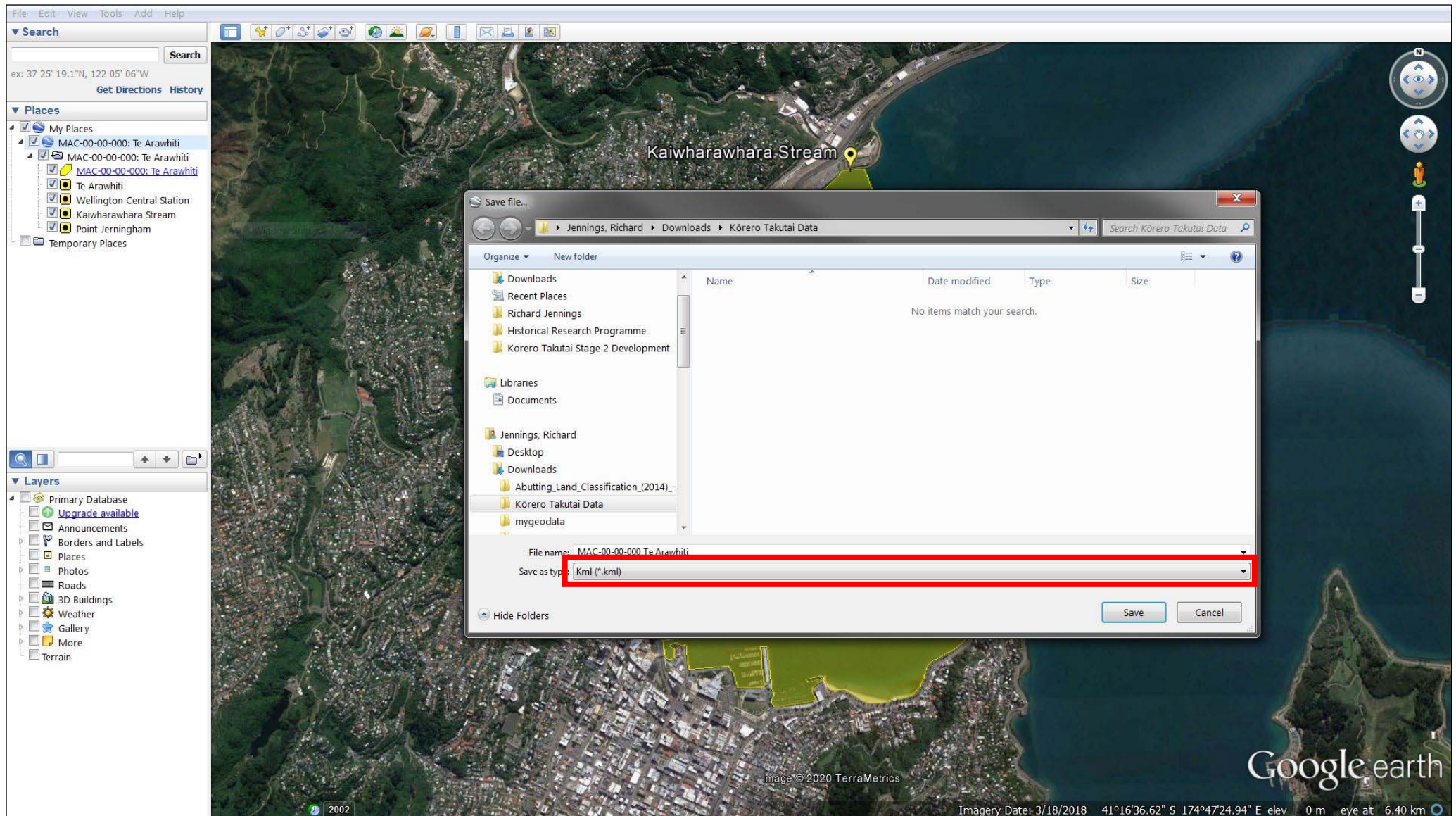
2. The data should be stored in either the 'My Places' or 'Temporary Places' folders in the window to the right-hand side of the map.



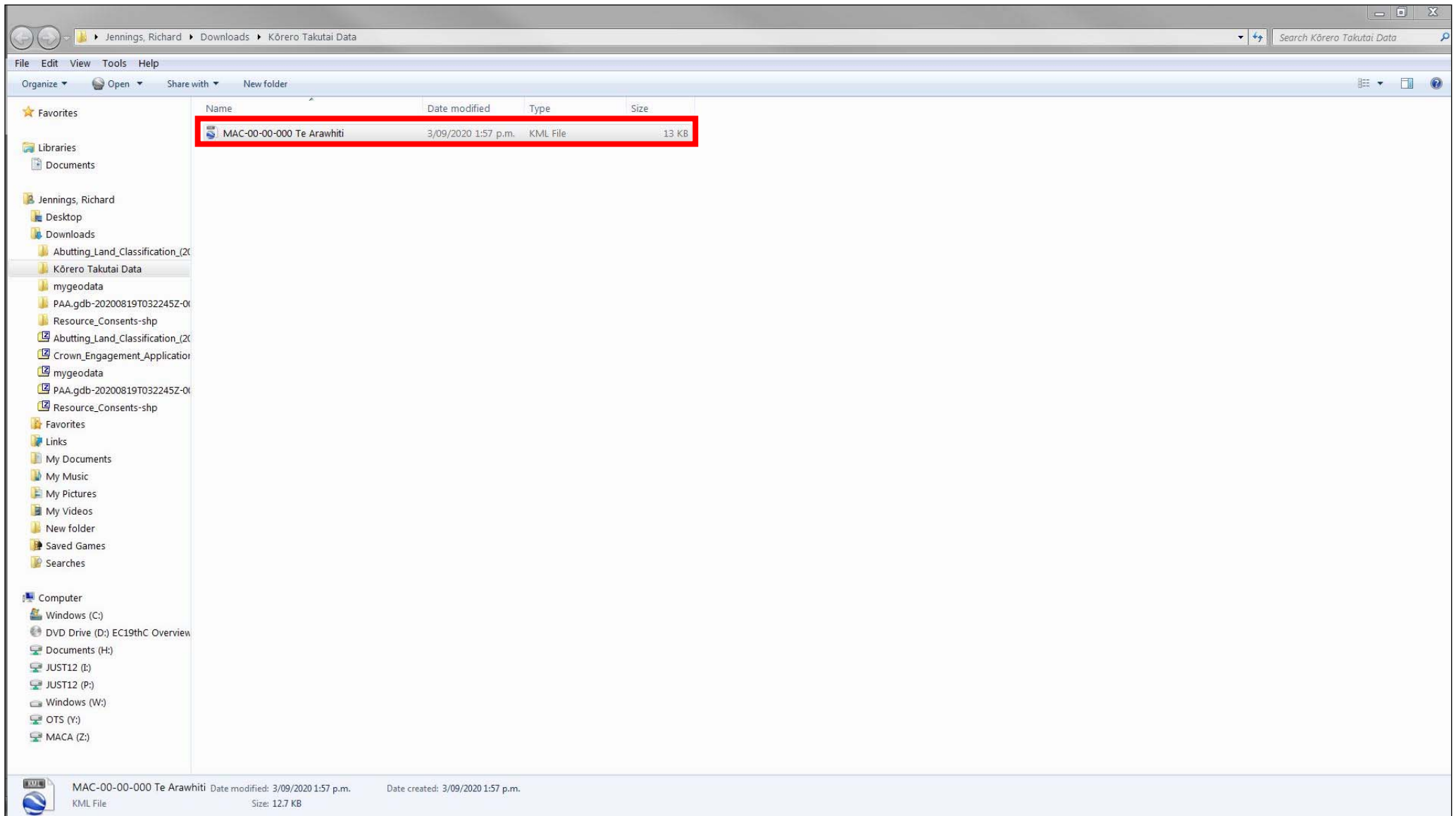
3. Right click on the root folder that your data is stored in. Select 'save place as' from the menu.



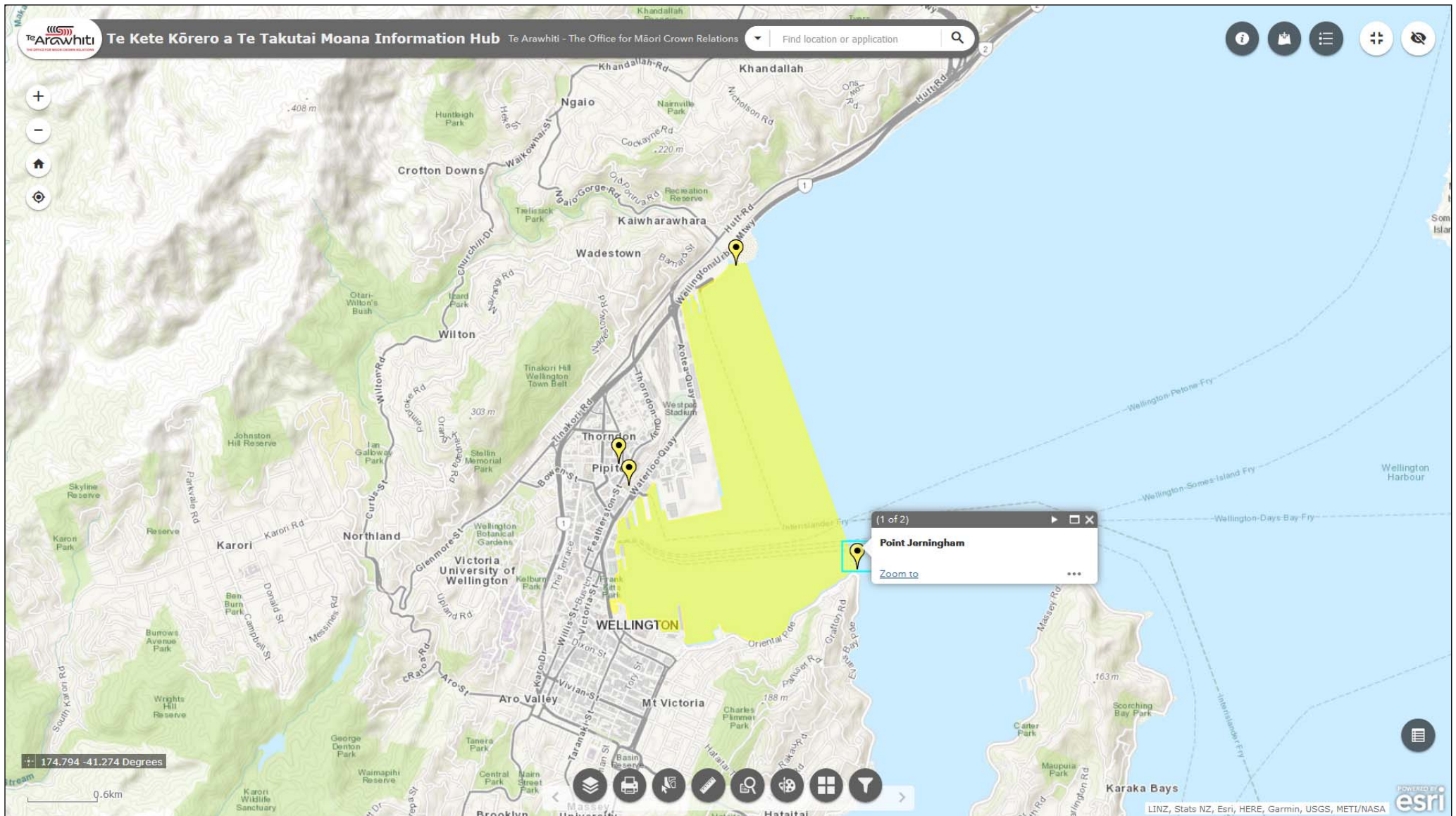
4. Select which folder on your computer you would like to save the data to, and the name you would like to give the file.



5. Select 'Kml' from the 'save as type' drop-down menu. This is very important as Kml files are not compatible with Kōrero Takutai. Then click 'save'.



6. You should now have the file saved to your computer.
