To date, 17% of the applicant groups we contacted have reached back out to us. Your responses help us to keep current contact information for future engagement. This ensures we can provide updates on key information about your application.

It's not too late to respond

If you received correspondence but haven't yet responded, it's not too late.

We welcome responses at any time and encourage applicant groups to confirm their contact details so we can keep you informed about future developments relating to your application.

What happens next?

Over the coming months, Te Tari Whakatau will continue making further attempts to contact applicant groups that have not yet responded.

This may include using different contact methods or confirming contact details through other appropriate channels where necessary.

Our aim is to provide every applicant group with a meaningful opportunity to engage with us. In order to achieve this, we will be carrying out some follow up outreach.
