TO BE ELIGIBLE TO STAND FOR ELECTION AS A REPRESENTATIVE

A nominee (candidate):

- ✓ must be identified by the Māori Land Court as Hāwea/Wānaki SILNA successor, as evidenced:
either on the 18th May 2023 list released by the Māori Land Court (refer to the SILNA page of the Māori Land Court website: www.maorilandcourt.govt.nz) **or** by way of a Māori Land Court order made since 18 May 2023 but before the end of the nomination period (5.00pm, Monday 18 September 2023).
- ✓ can self-nominate, or be nominated by another Hāwea/Wānaka SILNA successor as identified by the Māori Land Court (as above)
- ✓ may provide a photo of themselves and a short bio (no more than 150 words), which will be distributed with voting packs

1. Nomination papers must be received by **5.00pm, Monday 18 September 2023** and can be submitted by:

** if submitting by post, the envelope must be postmarked by 18 September 2023 and be received by Thursday 28 September 2023 to be accepted.*
2. If you are a Hāwea/Wānaka SILNA successor as determined by the Māori Land Court **since 18 May 2023**, you must provide the Returning Officer the court order recognising you as a Hāwea/Wānaka SILNA successor along with this nomination form, to either be a nominator or nominee/candidate.
3. If you are a Hāwea/Wānaka SILNA successor recognised by the Māori Land Court, you can nominate **up to five nominees**, including yourself.
4. You will need to complete a separate nomination form for each nominee/candidate you wish to nominate. For additional forms, go to: www.electionservices.co.nz/SILNA2023
5. Each nomination **should be accompanied with a candidate profile statement/bio** (attached), and a **current passport-size photo**. Nominees/candidates should be aware that this information will be made publicly available for voting purposes. Photos should preferably be in colour and may be submitted in hard-copy or electronically. If supplied in electronic format, it should be provided by email in a jpg format.
6. A nominee/candidate **must sign the nomination paper** to show their consent to the nomination. Failure to do so will make the nomination invalid.
7. Every nominee/candidate will need to confirm on the nomination paper that they have read and understood the Terms of Reference for the proposed Representative Body and associated responsibilities. These are available to view online at: www.electionservices.co.nz/SILNA2023
