

DEFINITIONS OF EACH MEMBER OF THE COLLECTIVE

1. For the purposes of clauses 1.5 to 1.7 of the Deed:

Ngāi Tūhoe

1.1 **Ngāi Tūhoe:**

1.1.1 means the iwi of Ngāi Tūhoe, being the collective group composed of:


- (a) those persons who descend from the eponymous ancestors, Tūhoe or Pōtiki; and
- (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.1.3(a);

1.1.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.1.1; and

1.1.3 includes the following subgroups:

- (a) Hapuoneone, Kākahu Tāpiki (Ngāti Kākahutāpiki), Kurī Kino (Ngāti Kuri), Murakareke, Ngā Maihi, Ngā Pōtiki, Ngai Te Rūrehe (Ngāi Te Riu), Ngai Taraparoa, Ngai Tātua, Ngai Te Amohanga, Ngai te Au, Ngai Te Kahu, Ngai Te Kapo o te Rangī (Ngāi Te Kapo), Ngai Tūmatawhā, Ngai Tūranga Pikitoi, Ngāti Hā, Ngāti Haka Patuheuheu, Ngāti Hāmua, Ngāti Hape, Ngāti Haua, Ngāti Hiki, Ngāti Hinekura, Ngāti Hinewhakarau, Ngāti Karetehe, Ngāti Koirā, Ngāti Korokaiwhenua, Ngāti Kōurakino (Ngāti Kōura), Ngāti Kūmara, Ngāti Manunui, Ngāti Maru, Ngāti Mātaatua, Ngāti Matewai, Ngāti Murahīoi, Ngāti Muriwai, Ngāti Pakitua, Ngāti Peehi, Ngāti Raka, Ngāti Rākei, Ngāti Rautao, Ngāti Rere, Ngāti Rerekahika, Ngāti Rongokārae (Ngāti Rongo), Ngāti Ruapani ki Waikaremoana*, Ngāti Ruatāhuna, Ngāti Ruri, Ngāti Tahu, Ngāti Tamakere, Ngāti Tamatea, Ngāti Tamatuhirae / Ngāti Tama, Ngāti Tāwhaki, Ngāti Te Paena, Ngāti Te Umuiti, Ngāti Tūmatawhero, Ngāti Wehi o te Rangī, Tamakaimōana, Tamaruarangi, Te Māhurehure, Te Mārangaranga, Te Urewera, Te Warahoe, Te Whakatāne, Te Whānau ā Ēria, Tūhoe Pōtiki and Whānaupani; and
- (b) any iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.1.1;

* Ngāti Ruapani ki Waikaremoana may or may not be part of Ngāi Tūhoe for the purposes of this Settlement and Ngāi Tūhoe's Future Comprehensive Settlement. It is included in paragraph 1.1(a) above pending the resolution of the issue at a hui of Ngāi Tūhoe to be held on 12 July 2008

Ngāti Manawa

1.2 Ngāti Manawa:

1.2.1 means the iwi of Ngāti Manawa, being the collective group composed of:

- (a) individuals descended from the following ancestors:
 - (i) Apa Hapaitaketake ki Ngāti Manawa; and
 - (ii) Tangiharuru's unions with:
 - (A) Takuate; or
 - (B) Kuranui; or
 - (C) Kuraroa; or
 - (D) Kuraiti; and
- (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.2.3(a);

1.2.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.2.1; and

1.2.3 includes the following subgroups:

- (a) Ngāti Koro, Ngāti Hui and Ngāi Tokowaru; and
- (b) any iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.2.1;

Ngāti Tūwharetoa

1.3 Ngāti Tūwharetoa:

1.3.1 means the iwi of Ngāti Tūwharetoa, being the collective group composed of individuals descended from one or more Ngāti Tūwharetoa ancestors;

1.3.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.3.1; and

1.3.3 includes any iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.3.1;

Ngāti Whakaue

1.4 Ngāti Whakaue:

1.4.1 means the iwi of Ngāti Whakaue, being the collective group composed of individuals descended from one or more Ngāti Whakaue ancestors;

1.4.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.4.1; and

1.4.3 includes any iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.4.1;

Ngāti Whare

1.5 Ngāti Whare:

1.5.1 means the iwi of Ngāti Whare, being the collective group composed of:

- (a) individuals descended from the eponymous ancestor Wharepakau; and
- (b) individuals who are members of the subgroups referred to in paragraph 1.5.3(a);

1.5.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.5.1; and

1.5.3 includes the following subgroups:

- (a) Ngāti Tuahiwi, Ngāti Te Au, Ngāti Whare ki Ngā Potiki, Ngāti Te Karaha, Ngāti Mahanga, Ngāti Kohiwi, Ngāti Hamua ki Te Whaiti and Warahoe ki Te Whaiti; and
- (b) any iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.5.1;

Raukawa

1.6 Raukawa:

1.6.1 means the iwi of Raukawa, being the collective group composed of all those people who descend from Raukawa and affiliate to a Raukawa marae in the Waikato area;

1.6.2 means every individual referred to in paragraph 1.6.1; and

1.6.3 includes any iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals to the extent that that iwi, hapū, whanau, or group of individuals is composed of individuals referred to in paragraph 1.6.1; and

The Affiliate Te Arawa Iwi/Hapū

- 1.7 **The Affiliate Te Arawa Iwi/Hapū** has the meaning given to it in the TPT Settlement Deed.
2. For the purposes of paragraph 1 above a person is descended from another person if the first person is descended from the other by:
 - 2.1 birth;
 - 2.2 legal adoption; or
 - 2.3 to the extent relevant to a Member of the Collective, Māori customary adoption in accordance with the tikanga of that Member of the Collective.
3. The Parties acknowledge that the definitions in paragraph 1 may be developed further in Future Comprehensive Settlements of the Members of the Collective and agree that paragraphs 1 and 2 are to be interpreted in a manner consistent with the relevant Future Comprehensive Settlement.
